The Motor and Boat Identification Manual can help identify classic, vintage and antique boats and manufacturers. Last updated in 1996, this manual is a great starting point for identifying your boat.

Compiled using Coast Guard information, this manual details more than 12,000 boat manufacturers in production from 1972-1996.

Provided is complete information on manufacturers' addresses, phone numbers, identification codes (MIC) and business status at the time of publication (1996). Manufacturers are listed alphabetically by name and by MIC for quick and easy cross-reference.

This manual also contains identifying model and specification information on stern drive engines and outboard motors.

Stern drive coverage includes MerCruiser engines from 1963-1996 and OMC engines from 1964-1996 with identifying specifications on engine make and model, horsepower and size in cubic inches.

Outboard coverage includes 25 manufacturers from 1921-1996, ranging from Aquabug to Yamaha. Included are detailed specifications including serial number, horsepower, rated RPM, number of cylinders, bore and stroke, and size in cubic inches.
