- 1. Remove fuel filter from fuel line.
- 2. Unscrew and remove the filter end marked "IN".
- 3. Remove glass sleeve, magnet & spring.
- 4. Remove spindle by turning counter clockwise.
- 5. Remove the used element and discard.
- 6. Replace "O" rings on end caps if required (Replace only if originals are leaking or appear cracked or torn).
- 7. Place a new element on the spindle and screw back into "OUT" end cap. Screw firmly to properly seat element at both ends.
- 8. Replace glass sleeve. Replace spring and then magnet on spindle.
- 9. Screw "IN" end cap onto spindle just slightly tighter than finger tight.

Do Not Over Tighten

- 10. Replace filter in fuel line.
- 11. Start engine and check for leaks.

CAUTION: Gasoline and its vapors are extremely explosive.

Observe installation safety precautions. Do not smoke. Install in well ventilated area away from flame and sparks.
