


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR SEACHOICE OUTRIGGER POLE HOLDERS

READ ALLINSTRUCTIONS BEFORE PROCEEDING

These outrigger pole holders are designed to be mounted with the tubular portion of the plates slanting aft, as shown below.

- The above outrigger pole holders must be mounted on a surface that allows approximately 3 inches of clearance below the flange. The poles should be parallel when in their vertical position.
- 2) 'Using a hole saw, cut a 1-1/2 inch hole for Cat. No. 88751 at a 45° angle to the mounting surface and in a forward direction. It may be necessary to start the hole by cutting straight down and then turning to the desired angle.
- If necessary trim the hole with a rasp or file so that the flange fits flat onto the mounting surface (see diagram). Do not attempt to draw the flange down with the mounting bolts, otherwise damage to the holder will result.
- Using the outrigger pole holder plate as a guide, mark the four mounting holes. Remove the holder plate and drill holes for four 1 /4 inch flat or oval head mounting bolts.
- Place holder plate in place and secure it with the four 1/4 inch mounting boits.
- The outriggers with their trolling pin or clip, lead lines and guides should be installed on the boat as indicated by the diagrams below. The line to the pulley should be tight enough to prevent the pole and holder from vibrating out of the holder socket.






OUTRIGGER POLE HOLDER INSTALLATION

- Mount base in area with at least 3" of clearance below flange
- Using a hole saw (1-1/2"), cut hole at approximately 45° angle in the forward direction. It may be neccesary to trim with a rasp or file so that the flange seats flat to mounting surface. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO DRAW FLANGE DOWN WITH THE MOUNTING BOLTS, AS THIS COULD DAMAGE HOLDER
- Use flange to mark holes & drill to secure with 1/4" flat or oval stainless steel bolts (not included)

RIGGING POLES

- · Mount stainless steel strap eye between outrigger and fishing pole holder
- · Attach snap of snubber to strap eye
- Tie end of rigging line to trolling clip, feed line through glass eye on snubber and through guides on (extended) outrigger pole, and leaving desired amount of excess line, cut and tie to other end of trolling clip
- The snubber is intended to keep tension on rigging line in order to maintain trolling clip (with fishing line) at desired distance up on the outrigger pole
