



Thank you for purchasing the Long Run Bunk Guides. Please review the following instructions before starting the assembly. With proper care, the Bunk Guides will give you years of service.

- Before assembling the mounting hardware as shown on above, decide where and which set up you will want the bunk guides placed on your trailer. (Use the diagrams on back to determine bunk board placement.)
- 2. Using 4 3/8"x 5" hex head bolts, 8 flat washers and 4 nyloc nuts, for each, attach the guide support mounts onto your trailer frame, as shown in figure 1. Use the holes that will keep the bolts closest to the frame tube. Finger tighten at this time. Repeat for other side.
- 3. Slide the guide support tube into the assembly as shown in figure 1.



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- 4. With the guide support tubes mounted in place, measure the outside width and install swivel brackets on the 60" bunk boards accordingly.
- 5. Use a 3/8"x 2-1/2" hex head bolt and washers and 3/8" nyloc nut to attach the bunk to the guide support tube. Insert end cap cover over steel tube Repeat for both sides.
- 6. Adjust the guide tubes for the proper distance on each side. Tighten support mount bolts at this time.
- 7. Adjust the bunks for the proper angle and tighten the bolts.
